Travellers can fly directly to Bali given:

- they have B211A eVisa for **Tourism purposes** and are residents/citizens of one of the 19 countries (Saudi Arabia, UAE, New Zealand, Kuwait, Bahrain, Qatar, China, India, Japan, South Korea, Lichtenstein, Italy, France, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Poland, Hungary & Norway) + ***able to find flights arriving internationally to Bali***
- they are from other countries and have business sponsored B211A eVisa for **Business purposes** + ***able to find flights arriving internationally to Bali***
- they have KITAS + ***able to find flights arriving internationally to Bali***



To clarify common misinformation:

- **only travellers from specified 19 countries are now permitted to apply for **tourism B211A**. Before travellers could only apply for business sponsored B211A. Citizens outside 19 specified countries, are still welcome to apply for B211A business sponsored visa, but not for tourism B211A**
- **everyone can fly internationally to Bali, whether you hold B211A issued for Tourism reasons, or B211A issued for Business reasons**
- ***IMPORTANT* ➔ Bali Airport is open for international arrivals, HOWEVER, airlines will not fly in until they see this route commercially viable. Airlines are said to be attempting landing internationally in Bali no earlier than November '21**



To clarify common misinformation:

- if your direct international flight to Bali gets canceled, you can still enter Indonesia via Jakarta. This means you first fly to Jakarta, quarantine there as per the government's regulations, and upon quarantine completion fly domestically to Bali
- You **MUST** quarantine at first entry point to Indonesia. This means you cannot transit via Jakarta and quarantine in Bali. If you land in Jakarta, you quarantine in Jakarta prior travelling to Bali
- As of 14 October 2021 mandatory quarantine is 5 days (5 x 24h). For quarantine pricing please check directly with quarantine hotels.
